Brief mention is made of the growing conditions needed by different crops and the seasonality of foods, the need to import and preserve food.</p>	<p>Where in the world does my food come from?</p> <p>This worksheet looks at where the ingredients in a bag of crisps or tin of soup come from and how getting these ingredients into our food may involve a lot of work and long distances of travel. It can be used independently of the site and makes a good homework.</p>	<p>This section is best looked at after studying Carbon footprint. It can be set as a homework activity in conjunction with the worksheet.</p>
